“Westwood Winery Twenty One is a Rhone styled blend of Syrah, Grenache and Mourvèdre from the Annadel Gap Vineyard in Sonoma. All of the fruit is farmed Biodynamically, with minimal intervention. The end result is a sensational wine which begins with aromas of dark cherries, black raspberries, blueberries, ripe plum, herbs, smoke, sweet spice, lavender, and a dash of white pepper. On the palate this is medium-bodied with a gorgeous velvety texture and notable concentration. It continues to impress with its remarkable overall balance and finesse all the way through the finish. Overall, this is a simply gorgeous wine which has the potential to evolve gracefully for years to come, be sure to allow it some time.”
