2017 ROSÉ WINE ANNADEL GAP VINEYARD

Pinot Noir , Counoise , Syrah, Mourvedre | pH: 3.28 | TA: 6.66g/L | Brix: 21.7-25 | Abv: 14.1%

A portion of this blend was intentionally picked early for the express purpose of making rosé, and whole cluster pressed. The balance of the blend was collected as saignee, or bleed off, from the sorting line. All varietals were individually fermented in neutral French oak aged sur lie for four months, undergoing partial malolactic fermentation, and blended in tank for a further two months of maturation. Gently fined and filtered.

AROMATICS

Flinty and tightly wound, pink rose petal, wild raspberry, strawberry of jasmine tea, and wild herbs.

PALATE

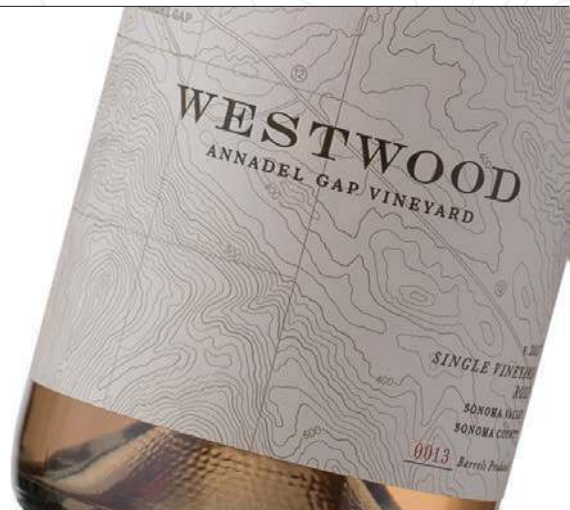
