Tasting Notes

Floral aromatics first hit the nose, followed by tart apple, lime zest, and wild honey. The palate opens with citrus, lemongrass, apricot, and lemon verbena, laced with wet granite. Precise and tightly wound, the wine shows good length and a lingering minerality.

Vineyard

The Annadel Gap Vineyard is a special place. Located between Mt. Hood and the Sonoma Mountains, our site is characterized by thick morning fog and strong afternoon winds. Alluvial, glacial, and sedimentary influences create a wide array of soil types. Ideal growing conditions, varied soils, and our minimal-impact farming methods yield precise, balanced fruit.

Winemaking

The fruit was hand-harvested at night and whole-cluster pressed. The juice was fermented in a neutral French oak barrel and a stainless steel drum, then aged in stainless steel drums for 4 months, where it went through partial malolactic fermentation. Gently fined, filtered, and bottled.
