“A red blend made with 68% Syrah, 20% Mourvedre, and 12% Grenache, all Biodynamically certified, Westwood's flagship should be called an SMG rather than a GSM - one that transports you to the Old World with its earthy nose, savory black fruit, and hint of garrigue and blood. Extremely complex, with volcanic and graphite notes as well as massive tannins that coat the tongue with dense and exotic spices. It's named for Westwood's 21st anniversary.”
